

NPAAA selects its 8th "Lifetime Achievement" Hall of Fame Inductee

The NPAAA Board of Directors selected its 8th "Lifetime Achievement" Hall of Fame Inductee. The North Penn Alumni Athletic Association Lifetime Achievement Hall of Fame will honor North Penn High School and Legacy School graduates who have made significant contributions to society in the Arts, Business, Education, Legal, Medical, Performing Arts, Public Service, or the Sciences fields of endeavor.

The NPAAA Selection Committee has named Juliana Schulte O'Reilly, NPHS class of 1982 as the 2018 Lifetime Achievement Inductee. Juliana S. O'Reilly is the SVP & Managing Counsel, Regulatory, Banking & Insurance of American Express and sits on the leadership team of the Company's General Counsel and its President of Global Banking. She leads a team of professionals who provide direct support to American Express as a bank holding company, to its major U.S. based banking and insurance entities, American Express Bank, FSB, American Express Centurion Bank, American Express Banking Corp. ("AEBC"), Amex Assurance Company and Amexco and to the boards of directors of those entities. She also counsels on financial services matters globally. Juliana has a primary role in working with the Federal Reserve Board and the Federal Reserve Bank of New York in their roles as holding company supervisor for the Company. From 2009-2013, Juliana was the General Counsel of AEBC and had a primary role in working with the NYDFS. From 2008-2013, Juliana lead the Company's prepaid legal and money transmitter licensing team during the business' rapid product expansion from travelers cheques into general purpose reloadable prepaid products, including Bluebird® and Serve®.

She has served in leadership roles for various bar associations and non-profit organizations. Juliana served as Vice Chair of the American Bar Association's Banking Law Committee for 9 years and currently sits on the Executive Committee and is Audit Committee Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Virginia Athletics Foundation. She previously served as a Trustee of the College Foundation of the University of Virginia and its predecessor organization, the University of Virginia Arts & Sciences Council, for 11 years including as Chair of its Audit Committee.

Juliana graduated from the George Washington University Law School and received her B.A. degree in History from the University of Virginia. She was an All-American and captain of the UVA Women's Swimming & Diving Team and qualified for Olympic Trials.

Julianna was inducted into the NPAAA Hall of Fame with the 4th Induction class in 2008. She is the second person to be inducted into both the NPAAA Athletic Hall of Fame and the Lifetime Achievement Hall of Fame.

2018 NPAAA PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Membership: MEMBERSHIP STANDS AT 490. HELP THE NPAAA REACH THE MILESTONE 500!!

As you know, the NPAAA depends on memberships and donations to support its mission.

The fact is North Penn High School is one of the largest high schools in Pennsylvania and graduates around 1,000 students each year. The NPAAA which was founded in 2000 and currently has 490 paid members. Given the size of the school and the unbelievable success of the athletic program, we should have at least 1,000 members by this time. I have determined that one of the issues is awareness. A great percentage of our graduates do not even know we exist. This is the result of factors beyond our control, such as demographic issues. After graduation our alumni move away for any number of reasons and lose contact with NPHS and their classmates and teammates.

The one possible solution is for our existing membership, of which we are very proud, to get involved and reach out to classmates and teammates, tell them about the NPAAA, and ask them to become lifetime members. The lifetime membership is a one time \$50 fee.

The fact is we need to increase our Lifetime Membership each year by around 50 to generate enough revenue to support the mission. The annual budget for the scholarships, Hall of Fame, and operating costs is roughly \$6,500.00.

In the 18 years since our founding in 2000, including 2018, the NPAAA has provided <u>137 scholarships for a total of</u> <u>\$73,503</u>, inducted <u>172 individual athletes</u>, <u>38 championship teams</u>, <u>8 Lifetime Achievement Inductees</u>, <u>16 Special Recognition Teams and 1 Special Recognition Individual.</u>

The NPAAA was founded with the mission of helping our student athletes by providing scholarships to help them with their future; the Hall of Fame was established to honor and document the history of our outstanding athletic accomplishments of the past. By establishing this tradition, which has been built by student athletes, coaches, teachers, parents, etc., we have created not only a source of pride but a standard of excellence for current students to emulate.

Please consider helping the NPAAA continue this important mission with financial support, membership recruitment, and if possible personal involvement in the work of the organization.
